Experian AutoCheck Score

The AutoCheck Score summarizes AutoCheck data into an easy-to-understand “score” and an equivalent vehicle score range.

- Compares vehicles of similar class and age based on a scale of 1 to 100.
- Predict the likelihood the car will be on the road in 5 years.
- Understand a vehicle’s predicted reliability as it pertains to vehicle age, number of owners, accidents, mileage, vehicle class, and vehicle use.

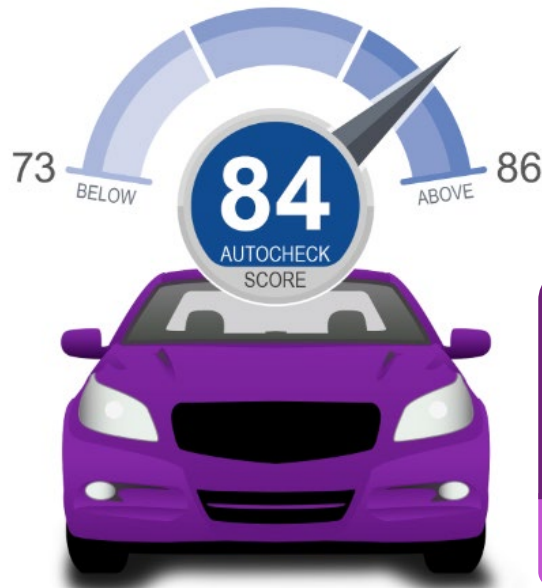


In this example, the score range is 76-89. For similar vehicles in this class, 76 is below average and 89 is above average

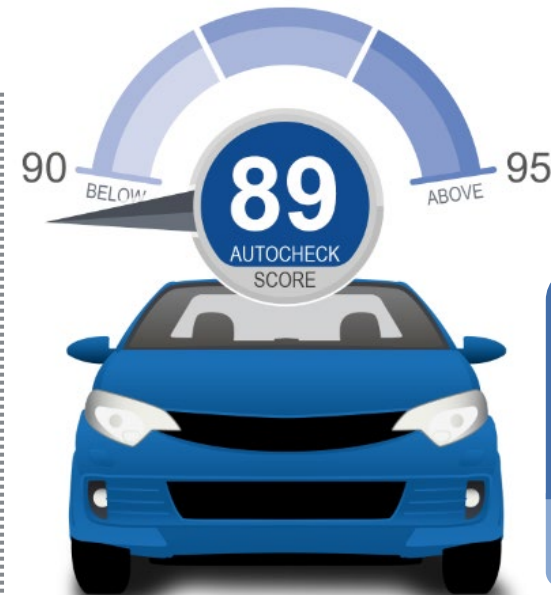
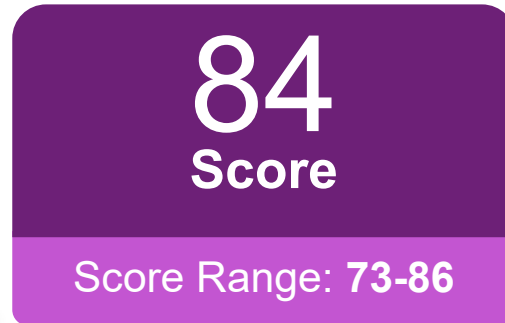
Experian AutoCheck Score® Example



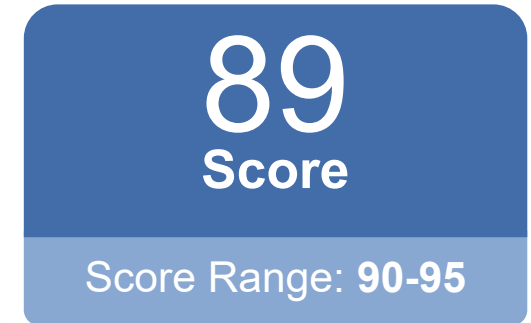
The Experian AutoCheck Score is based on a scale of 1 to 100, but it's important to read the Score in conjunction with the **Score Range**, which is based on a vehicle's age and class.



Car #1:
1999 Nissan Maxima



Car #2:
2005 Chevrolet Malibu



In this example, the score of 84 in the first car is actually better than the score of 89 in the second car as it was between the range of 73-86 in similar age and class whereas the second one is lower than the range of 90-95 in similar age and class.
